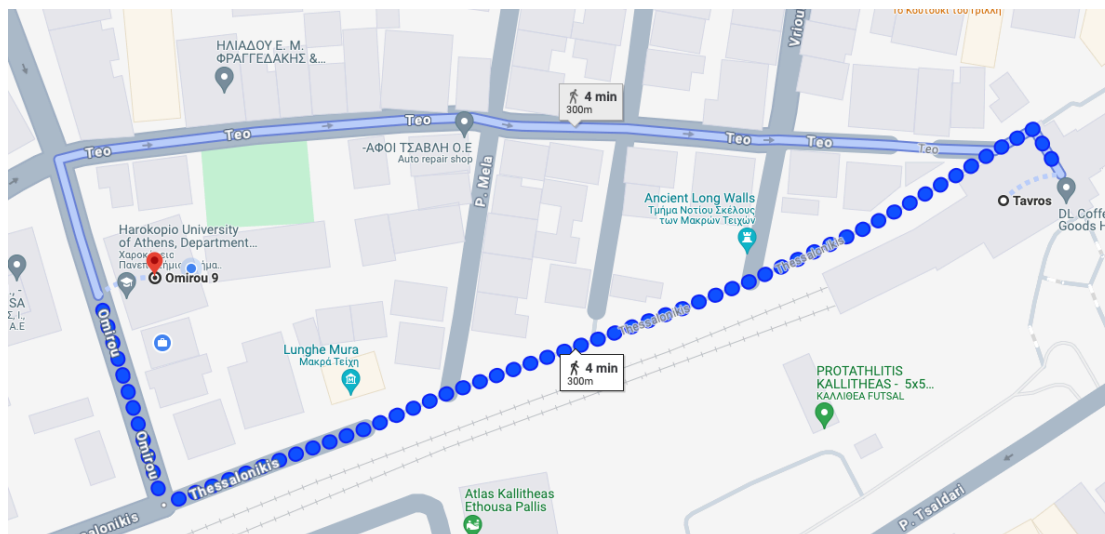
TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

Arrival to the hotel of your choice from the Airport

- Upon exiting the arrivals area of the airport, you can take a normal taxi outside of the airport (or even use the train station from the airport to Athens city center) to reach the hotel. Price is around 30€, dependent on the time and traffic.
- Athens airport metro station is located at the airport's second level, at the Departures area, and offers transportation services from and to Athens Airport. The Blue Line (Metro Line 3) connects Athens International Airport to Syntagma Square, the major hub of the city, in just 40 minutes.
- To use the train station, follow the signs directing you to the train station. The airport train station is located adjacent to the main terminal building. A one-way subway ticket from Athens Airport to Syntagma Square costs 9€ for adult passengers and 4.5€ for children, students, and elders. The price for a return ticket is 16€, while children under 6 years old travel for free. You can purchase your tickets at the airport station ticket booths or through the automatic machines. Please keep in mind that frequent inspections take place at the airport metro line, so ensure that you validate your ticket using the validation machines provided.
- Alternatively, if you are planning to wander around the city during your visit, you should buy a 3-day tourist ticket, valid for buses, metro, and tram. The 3-day ticket includes a return ticket to Athens Airport and costs 20€.

Arrival to Harokopio University (Dept. of Informatics and Telematics building)

The address of the venue is: **Omirou 9, Tavros 177 78, Greece** and the department's building is located 300m from the "Tavros" Train station (4 min by foot)
