## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

## Requirements:

Good level of English (equivalent to a minimum B2 in accordance to the CEFR) Availability for both, virtual and presential mobility.

## How to apply:

Each candidate must come with a short mobility (if they are students) or a training mobility (for teachers), financed by his/her institution.

If anyone is interested in joining, he/she must talk with his/her department of International Relations or Mobilities Erasmus from his/her institution to know if there is a possible Erasmus+ call for his/her financing in his/her university.

Once that he/she verify that he/she is eligible to ask for this mobility at his/her institution, she/he must write an email to the host university (cooperacioninternacional@unileon.es), with the topic "interest in joining the seminar Conference International development", and copying to his/her international office to let them know if they are admitted.

The coordinator of this BIP will write you back to both (candidate and institution) to tell you both if you are admitted.

Places are limited to 20 participants and will be filled in strict order of registration. Last day for asking for joining is, March 20, 2024.
